



- 1) Train journeys in Poland are operated by various carriers.
- 2) Not all of them accept Interrail and Eurail passes. When planning your trip, make sure to check which carrier serves the specific connection.

Interrail and Eurail (Global Pass and Poland Pass) are valid on trains operated by the following carriers:



[PKP Intercity S.A.](#) (PKP IC) – EIP, EIC, IC, TLK – long-distance trains and EC – international trains



[POLREGIO S.A.](#) (POLREGIO, PR) – regional trains in most voivodeships in Poland + selected long-distance connections



[Koleje Dolnośląskie](#) (KD) – part of regional trains in the Lower Silesian Voivodeship



[PKP Szybka Kolej Miejska w Trójmieście Sp. z o.o.](#) (PKP SKM) – suburban trains in the Pomeranian Voivodeship



[Łódzka Kolej Aglomeracyjna](#) (ŁKA) – part of regional trains in the Łódź Voivodeship except for ŁKA Sprinter (ŁS) trains, which run between Warsaw and Łódź on weekends.

Polish Carriers that DO NOT ACCEPT Interrail and Eurail passes:

- Koleje Wielkopolskie (KW),
- Koleje Śląskie (KŚ),
- Koleje Małopolskie (KMŁ),
- Koleje Mazowieckie (KM),
- Warszawska Kolej Dojazdowa (WKD),
- Arriva RP,
- Additionally, Interrail and Eurail passes are not valid on Warsaw metro trains and narrow-gauge railways.

DOMESTIC TRAVEL (WITHIN POLAND)

On trains operated by POLREGIO, Koleje Dolnośląskie, and PKP SKM, SEAT RESERVATIONS ARE NOT AVAILABLE.

PKP Intercity trains for domestic travel require seat reservations. When purchasing a single-ticket, you automatically receive a reserved seat. This means that most travelers have a reserved seat. Interrail or Eurail Pass holder can buy a separate reservation at intercity.pl or ticket office at the railway station. In selected trains, seat reservations are mandatory, and without a reservation, you will be considered a passenger without a valid ticket, even if you have a completed travel calendar. Many connections are popular, so it is a good idea to purchase a seat reservation before starting your journey.

DETAILED INFORMATION REGARDING TRAVEL ON NATIONAL COMMUNICATIONS (ONLY TRAVEL WITHIN POLAND):

- Express Intercity Premium (EIP) – seat reservation is mandatory with an additional fee and must be purchased before the journey begins. Otherwise, even if you have a valid Interrail or Eurail Pass, you will be treated as a passenger without a valid ticket! You can buy it at bilet.intercity.pl, at [ticket offices of PKP Intercity](#) and other railway carriers in Poland for 43 PLN. You can buy them at ticket offices of selected railway authorities outside Poland for €10 or similar. If you have a reservation for e.g. €3, you will be asked to pay an additional 43 PLN on the train.
- Express Intercity (EIC) – seat reservation is not mandatory but is possible. Single tickets are sold with a seat reservation, so if a passenger with a reservation boards the train, you must give up your seat. You can also travel standing if all seats are reserved. You can purchase it on the website bilet.intercity.pl, at [PKP Intercity ticket offices](#), and other railway carriers in Poland, or at ticket offices of selected railway administrations outside of Poland. For travel in the comfort zone (4-seat compartments in 1st class of selected EIC trains), a full surcharge is required (50 PLN from Monday to Friday or 25 PLN on Saturdays and Sundays). You can purchase it at PKP Intercity ticket offices and other railway carriers in Poland.
- Intercity (IC) – seat reservation is mandatory for selected trains operated by electric multiple units ED161 PesaDart. Travel without a reservation will be considered as traveling without  a ticket. These trains are marked with  in the timetable. You can purchase the reservation on the website bilet.intercity.pl, at [PKP Intercity ticket offices](#), and other railway carriers in Poland, or at ticket offices of selected railway administrations outside of Poland..
- In other Intercity (IC) and Twoje Linie Kolejowe (TLK) trains (coaches with seats), seat reservation is optional (marked as  in the timetable). However, if someone with a reservation claims the seat, you must give it up. We recommend purchasing a reservation because single ticket buyers receive a seat reservation along with the ticket. Therefore, not having a reservation for Interrail or Eurail may result in standing during the journey. You can purchase it on the website bilet.intercity.pl, at [PKP Intercity ticket offices](#), and other railway carriers in Poland, or at ticket offices of selected railway administrations outside of Poland..
- Intercity (IC) and Twoje Linie Kolejowe (TLK) – sleeping or couchette compartments - for Interrail or Eurail, you must purchase a reservation with a full surcharge depending on the type of place. Additional tickets (reservation + surcharge) are available at ticket offices of selected railway administrations outside of Poland, [PKP Intercity ticket offices](#), and other railway carriers in Poland.

How to purchase seat reservations at bilet.intercity.pl

After selecting your desired connection, choose Interrail/Eurail/NRT/EWT/FIP/OSŽD as the type of discount, and select "seat reservation" (with a surcharge). The number of regular tickets will automatically be set to 0, and the number next to Interrail/Eurail/NRT/EWT/FIP/OSŽD will be 1.

- ✓ You can purchase one seat reservation per transaction.
- ✓ In the case of a connection with a transfer, you need to purchase seat reservations separately for each journey.
- ✓ If you want to purchase a reservation for several people, we recommend using the shopping cart and graphical reservation of seats.

INTERNATIONAL DAYTIME TRAVEL (TRAVEL OUTSIDE OF POLAND):

- If you are not a resident of any of the countries through which the journey will take place, you must have an Interrail or Eurail Global Pass or one-country tickets valid in these countries..
- If you are a resident of one of the countries through which the journey will take place, remember that the Interrail Global Pass is valid in your country of residence for only one outbound journey and one return journey.
- For travel on EIC and IC trains from Warsaw, Gdynia, and Przemyśl to Berlin and Frankfurt (Oder), it is mandatory to purchase a Pass fare ticket for €4.00 (payable in PLN in Poland) including seat reservation at the ticket office(Where, in Poland can this be bought?)
- For travel on other daytime trains to/from Poland, it is mandatory to purchase a seat reservation for €3,50 (payable in PLN in Poland).

INTERNATIONAL NIGHT TRAVEL (TRAVEL OUTSIDE OF POLAND)

You need to purchase a Pass ticket or a seat reservation, depending on availability and your choice: for sitting, lying, or sleeping. Prices depend on the train you choose:
